➤ Hurricane Season is June 1 – November 30. During Hurricane Season please bring in all items from your patios, including your patio furniture, when you are not here. This will help Ray, Allen and I when we are preparing for a storm.

➤ A Security Guard will be on property every Saturday and Sunday 12pm – 5pm through July. Please make sure your family and guests are provided a parking pass. The guard has been instructed to tow any vehicle that does not have an owner sticker or guest pass.

- Sea turtle nesting season is May 1st through October 31st. Lights adjacent to the beach MUST NOT BE VISABLE FROM THE BEACH. Please help us protect the turtles and comply with local lighting regulations. The regulations are strictly enforced by fines for violations. Keep balcony and porch lights turned off during the nesting season. Also, draw your drapes or blinds at night if your room is lighted. These few simple steps will greatly increase the chance that baby turtles will safely reach the ocean this summer and keep us in COMPLIANCE. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

 - Please remember that you must submit an architectural request form before replacing windows and doors. Permits must also be pulled when required by the county.
